## Manuelle Gautrand, Forum in Saint-Louis (France)



Thirteen blocks with pitched roofs form new facilities for sporting and cultural events in Saint-Louis, in the French region of Alsace, close to the German and Swiss borders. Designed by the Paris firm Manuelle Gautrand Architecture, the fragmented ensemble takes up 6,000 square meters of land and was built on a budget of 10 million euros. For a homogeneous effect, all the modules are completely clad with perforated metal plates, with orange tones that come from applying a pigmented varnish containing copper powder.
